Guidelines for Submissions

- All high school age students in Eastern Minnesota and Western Wisconsin are encouraged to participate in this exhibition.
- One submission per student will be accepted.
- Works in all media, two-dimensional and three-dimensional, will be accepted.
- Two-dimensional work must be no larger than 36 x 36".
- Two-dimensional work must be ready to hang, preferably with a picture wire. If the work is unframed, a hanging system must be provided – please call The Phipps with questions.
- Complete both copies of the submission form below; attach one securely to the artwork and give the other to a Phipps representative when dropping off the work.

Drop-off Dates and Directions to The Phipps

Tuesday, March 30 or Wednesday, March 31, from 8:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

The Phipps is located at 109 Locust Street in Hudson, Wisconsin. Take Hwy I-94 to Wisconsin Exit 1. This becomes Hwy 35 North. Turn left (west) on Locust Street.

Judge's Awards

A professional artist or arts educator from the region will award ribbons for first place, second place, third place, and in other categories.

Alice M. Stolpe Scholarship for the Arts
