Guidelines for Submissions

- All high school art teachers in Eastern Minnesota and Western Wisconsin who have student(s) participating in the concurrent Annual Area High School Art Exhibition are encouraged to participate in this exhibition.
- One submission per teacher will be accepted.
- Works in all media, two-dimensional and three-dimensional, will be accepted.
- Two-dimensional work must be no larger than 36 x 36".
- Two-dimensional work must be ready to hang, preferably with a picture wire. If the work is unframed, a hanging system (i.e. adequate Velcro strips) must be provided.
- Complete both copies of the submission form below; attach one securely to the artwork and give the other to a Phipps representative when dropping off the work.

Drop-off Dates

Submissions must be brought to The Phipps on **Tuesday, April 10 or Wednesday, April 11, from 8:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.**

Directions: The Phipps is located at 109 Locust Street in Hudson, Wisconsin. Take Hwy I-94 to Wisconsin Exit 1. This becomes Hwy 35 North. Turn left (west) on Locust Street.

Reception and Pick-up

There will be a reception for participating artists and their families on Sunday, May 6 from 1:30 to 3:00 p.m. Participants may pick up their work immediately following the reception, or on Monday, May 7 from 8:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Please be aware that all unclaimed work will be discarded on Tuesday, May 8.
